Dear Chadderton Friends

Receive very fraternal greetings from our Diocese of Araucanía. Through this, I want to sincerely thank you for the concern you have for us in considering us in your time of prayer.

Here I share some news from our diocese.

1. After the PANDEMIC, it has been very difficult to get up in all aspects of the life of the Church. For example little assistance for fear of contagion, many brothers without jobs and this also affected the budget of the Diocese. However, we remain in high spirits to get back on our feet both in evangelism and budget challenges. I beg your prayers for the brothers to have jobs.
2. Our Diocese is in search of a new bishop for reasons that my time has come to step down. Unfortunately, the first attempt last year was unsuccessful in finding the new bishop, it was a very difficult and frustrating time. But thank the Lord we continue with new optimism. We ask for your prayers that the servant be found for this position.
3. In our Diocese, our Rural Biblical Institute has been operating for years, and we care for it with great dedication. Thank the Lord that through this institution many brothers have been prepared for rural leadership, some of them are already pastors and others are on the way to ordination. In this institute

we get scholarships for the brothers so that they dedicate themselves to studying for a year the different subjects that this institute offers.

We beg your prayers so that more brothers appear to prepare.

4. As for my family, I thank the Lord that we are all well. The three children are all working and active in the Church, two of them are married each with one child, so I am a grandfather of two grandchildren.

We and my wife live in a small town called CHOL-CHOL, a well-known place in the Anglican sphere since the "Anglican Mission" in Araucanía began here.

During the PANDEMIC so far, some health repercussions have also happened. My wife had gallstone surgery and other treatments. But everything has turned out very favourably, only that she was very affected by fear of COVID.

I beg your prayers so that we continue in the work that the Church has entrusted to us.

Dear brothers, we are very pleased to keep you in prayer. Thank you so much for this connection of fellowship. May the Lord bless you and prosper you in all areas of your Church.
